### What is APIN?

The African American Prevention Intervention Network (APIN) is a national project designed to assist community-based organizations (CBOs) with intervention design, development, implementation and evaluation. The APIN builds capacity among CBOs through a variety of delivery mechanisms including: Information Transfer, Skills-Building, Technical Services, Technical Consultation and Technology Transfer.

The APIN is administered by Jackson State University, supported by a communications and dissemination core. Input is received via a national advisory board. Services are delivered by Prevention Intervention Centers (PICs). PICs are located in four regions of the United States and are operated by APIN Coalition members. The Northeastern PIC is operated by the National Association for Equal Opportunity in Higher Education; Southern PIC by Jackson State University; Midwestern PIC by South Side Help Center and Western PIC by Charles R. Drew University of Medicine & Science.
